

Appeal Regarding the Murder of SHAUNDAE JONES



In the early hours of Sunday, 27th April 2003 20 year old Shaundae Jones travelled with friends by car to Club Malabar in Dockyard. He left the nightclub at 3am and made his way back to the car. There were several people in the area at the time, either exiting Club Malabar or arranging transportation to other destinations. Shaundae was in the car talking with friends when his assailant walked through the crowd and shot him once in the chest.

Shaundae's murderer then made his way back through the crowd and escaped the scene on a motorcycle. Attempts were made to save Shaundae but he died from the gunshot wound. This murder was witnessed by numerous people. They collectively describe the offender as a dark skinned male of skinny build, at least 6'3" tall, wearing a red top with a hood and a black crash helmet.
